Development of the Consensus Organizing Model. Mike Eichler, founder of the Consensus Organizing Model, originally began his career as a conflict organizer. In the early 1980s Mike was contracted to work for the Perry Hilltop neighborhood of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The community was the target of "blockbusting" by several real estate agents, which involved provoking racial fears, flooding the market with home sales, and ultimately, decreasing property values.
