uncomplicated. You print a design with plastisol ink, but instead of printing it directly on the garment, you print the design on special paper. The paper is then passed through a conveyer dryer where the ink is heated until it has gelled just enough to be dry to the touch.

Printing Plastisol Transfers - Union Ink

Give up chewing gum. Gum is made of a synthetic rubber, aka plastic. Use matches instead of disposable plastic lighters, or invest in a refillable metal lighter. Use rechargeable batteries. Use a wooden cutting board, not a plastic board. Use a razor with replaceable blades instead of a disposable razor.
